For the Designer of Moss, a Store All His Own

Harry Allen, below, earned a reputation for quirky design with his 2004 cast-resin piggy banks that resemble real piglets, and with his fruit bowls made from actual fruit cast in resin, introduced earlier this year. But his eclectic body of work also includes the sleek interior of the high-end Moss store in SoHo and inexpensive lighting fixtures for Ikea. Now admirers can see the range of

his furniture and product design in a new showroom in the East Village.
